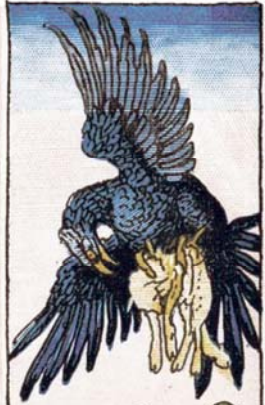
Now the cunning old Crow got his drink

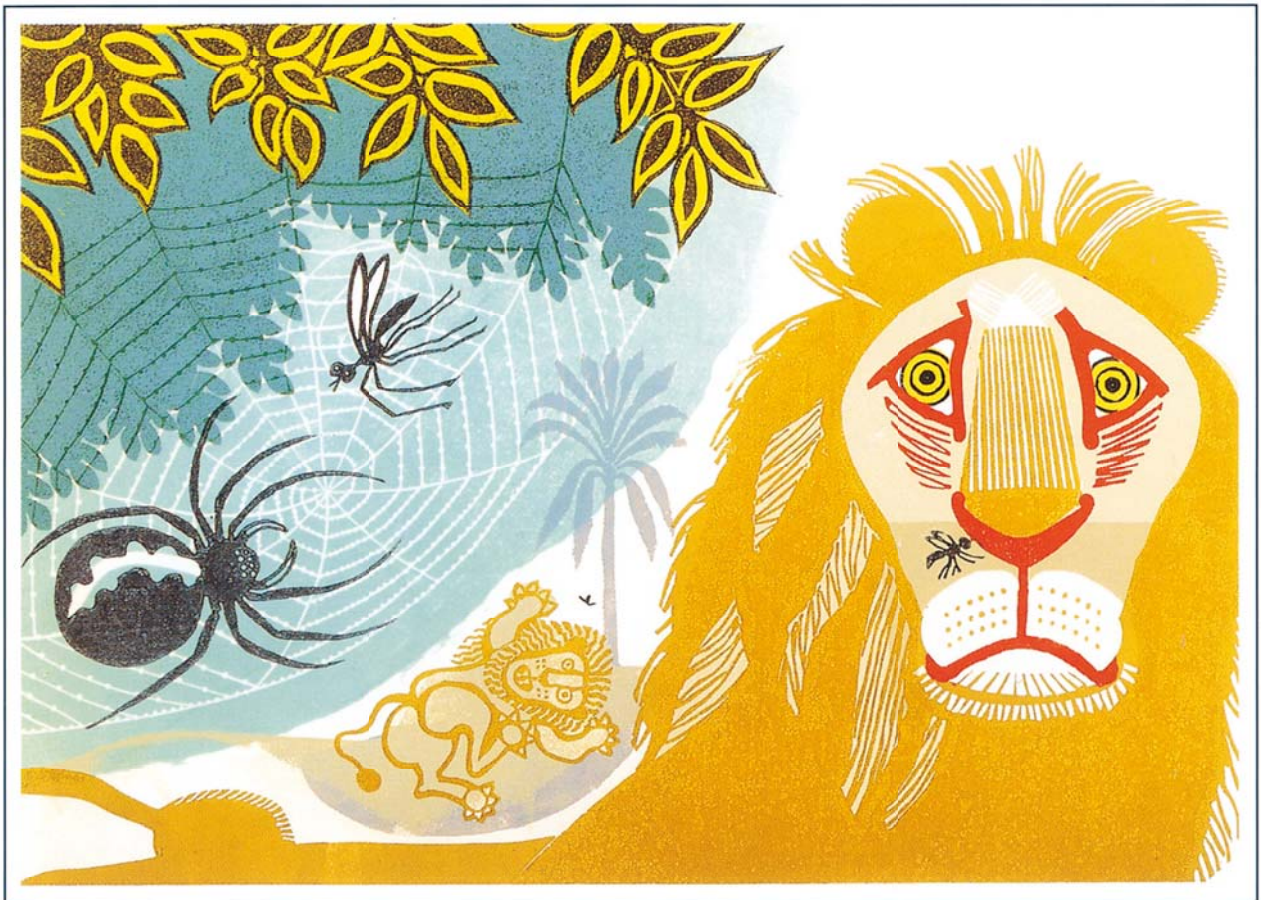
