## Introduction 簡介

#### 本書架構

#### 閱讀文章

本套書涵蓋豐富且多元的主題與體裁。文章形式廣泛蒐羅各類生活中常見的實用體裁,包含短文、歌詞、對話、電子郵件、書序、明信片、日記、卡片、訪談等三十餘種,以日常相關的生活經驗為重點編寫設計,幫助加強基礎閱讀能力,提升基本英語溝通能力,為基礎生活英語紮根。

收錄大量題材有趣、多元且生活化的短文,範圍囊括青少年生活、家庭、教育、娛樂、健康、節慶、動物、藝術、文學、科學、文化、旅遊等三十餘種,主題多元化且貼近生活經驗,可激起學生學習興趣,協助學生理解不同領域知識。



#### 閱讀測驗

每篇短文後,皆接有五題閱讀理解選擇題,評量學生對文章的理解程度。閱讀測驗所訓練學生的閱讀技巧包括:

文章中心思想 ( Main Idea ) / 主題 ( Subject Matter )

支持性細節 (Supporting Details) 從上下文猜測字義 (Words in Context)

文意推論 ( Making Inferences ) 看懂影像圖表 (Visualizing Comprehension

#### 文章中心思想(Main Idea)

閱讀文章時,讀者可以試著問自己:「作者想要傳達什麼訊息?」透過審視理解的方式,檢視自己是否了解文章意義。

#### 文章主題(Subject Matter)

這類問題幫助讀者專注在所閱讀的文章中,在閱讀文章前幾行後,讀者應該問自己:「**這篇文章是關於什麼?**」這麼做能幫助你立刻集中注意力, 快速理解文章內容,進而掌握整篇文章脈絡。



#### 支持性細節(Supporting Details)

每篇文章都是由細節組成來支持主題句。「**支持性細節**」包括範例、說明、敘述、定義、比較、對比和比喻。

#### 從上下文猜測字義(Words in Context)

由上下文猜生字意義,是英文閱讀中一項很重要的策略。弄錯關鍵字詞的意思會導致誤解作者想要傳達的觀點。

#### 文意推論(Making Inferences)



#### 看懂影像圖表(Visualizing Comprehension)


