訓練書特色説明

透過「斷句」掌握「即讀即解」的竅門

為了能更快、更正確地閱讀英文,就需要能夠掌握英文的句子結構。而要培養英文句子結構的敏鋭度,最好的方法就是以各「意義單元組」來理解句子,也就是將英文句子的「意義單元組」(具一個完整意義的片語或詞組),用斷句(chunk)的方式分開,然後再來理解句子。只要能理解各個「意義單元組」,那麼再長的句子,都能被拆解與理解。

聽力也是一樣,要區分「意義單元組」,這樣能幫助很快聽懂英文。例如下面這個句 子可以拆解成兩個部分:

I am angry at you.

I am angry / at you 我生氣 對你

我們會發現,這個句子由兩個「意義單元組」所組成。不管句子多長多複雜,都是由 最簡單的基本句型(主詞+動詞)發展而成,然後再在這個主要句子上,依照需求,添 加上許多片語,以表現各式各樣的句意。

在面對英文時,腦子裡能立刻自動快速分離基本句型和片語,就能迅速讀懂或聽懂英文。在讀誦英文時,從一個人的斷句,大致就能看出個人的英文能力。現在再來看稍微長一點的句子。經過斷句以後,整個句子變得更清楚易懂,閱讀理解就沒問題了:

Leonardo da Vinci painted / the most famous portrait / in the world: / the Mona Lisa. 里奥納多達文西畫了 最有名的肖像畫 全世界 (就是)蒙娜麗莎



一個句子有幾個斷句?

一個句子有幾個斷句?有幾個「意義單元組」?這是依句子的情況和個人的英語能力,而有不同的。一般來說,以下這些地方通常就是斷句的地方:

- ★在「主詞+動詞」之後
- ★ 在 and、but、or 等連接詞之前
- ★ 在 that、who 等關係詞之前
- ★ 在副詞、不定詞 to 等的前後

另外,主詞很長時,時常為了要區分出主詞,在主詞後也會斷句。例如:

Your neighbors / are the people / who live near you.

對初學者來說,一個句子裡可能會有很多斷句的斜線,而當閱讀能力越來越強之後,你需要斷句的地方就會越來越少,到後來甚至能一眼就看懂句子,不需要用斷句的方式來幫助理解。

本訓練書因為考慮到初學者,所以盡可能細分可斷句處,只要是能分為一個「意義單元組」的地方,訓練書上就標示出斷句。等你的英文實力逐漸提升,到了覺得斷句變成是一種累贅,能夠不用再做任何標記就能讀懂課文時,就是你的英文能力更進一階的時候了。透過斷句的練習,熟悉英語的排列順序和結構,你會驚訝地發現到,自己的閱讀能力突飛猛進!






